

## Materials Used:

Worsted weight yarn
Size H/8 (5.00mm) crochet hook
Yarn needle

## Size/Gauge:

Gauge is not important to this project, but made with materials used, finished square measures approximately 12 ".

## Stitches Used/Abbreviations:

Ch-chain
Sc-single crochet

## Instructions:

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Graph included for visual assistance. All stitches are Sc. Each square in the graph represents one stitch. I have written the counts for left and right handed, line-by line, for each color change. When you reach a new color on the graph, for that row, you drop the color you have, and pick up the new color, and continue to sc. When you are finished, weave in all ends. This particular graph has the instructions for the background/polka dots ONLY. The black stitches are embroidered on afterwards. You may incorporate them into the crochet, if you wish, but it will turn out a bit differently.


Row 1: With CA, ch 39. Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, and each remaining ch across.
Rows 2-3: ch 1, TURN. Sc in each st across.
Row 4: For RIGHT HAND: $C A \sim 26, C B \sim 4, C A \sim 8$ For LEFT HAND: $C A \sim 8, C B \sim 4$, CA~26
Row 5: FOR RIGHT HAND: $C A \sim 7, C B \sim 6, C A \sim 14, C C \sim 3, C A \sim 8$ For LEFT HAND: CA~8, CC~3, CA~14, CB~6, CA~7
Row 6: For RIGHT HAND: CA~7, CC~5, CA~13, CB~6, CA~7 For LEFT HAND: CA~7, CB~6, CA~13, CC~5, CA~7
Row 7: For RIGHT HAND: $C A \sim 7, C B \sim 6, C A \sim 13, C C \sim 5, C A \sim 7$ For LEFT HAND: CA~7, CC~5, CA~13, CB~6, CA~7
Row 8: For RIGHT HAND: $\mathrm{CA} \sim 8, \mathrm{CC} \sim 3, \mathrm{CA} \sim 15, \mathrm{CB} \sim 4, \mathrm{CA} \sim 8$ For LEFT HAND: CA~8, CB~4, CA~15, CC~3, CA~8
Rows 9-14: For BOTH: With CA, sc in each st across.
Row 15: For RIGHT HAND: CA~6, CD~4, CA~28 For LEFT HAND: CA~28, CD~4, CA~6
Row 16: For RIGHT HAND: CA~27, CD~6, CA~5 For LEFT HAND: CA~5,

CD~6, CA~27
Row 17: For RIGHT HAND: CA~5, CD~6, CA~27 For LEFT HAND: CA~27, CD~6, CA~5
Row 18: For RIGHT HAND: CA~27, CD~6, CA~5 For LEFT HAND: CA~5, CD~6, CA~27
Row 19: For RIGHT HAND: CA~5, CD~6, CA~20, CD~4, CA~3 For LEFT
HAND: CA~3, CD~4, CA~20, CD~6, CA~5
Row 20: For RIGHT HAND: CA~2, CD~6, CA~20, CD~4, CA~6 For LEFT
HAND: CA~6, CD~4, CA~20, CD~6, CA~2
Row 21: For RIGHT HAND: CA~30, CD~6, CA~2 For LEFT HAND: CA~2, CD~6 CA~30
Row 22: For RIGHT HAND: CA~2, CD~6, CA~30 For LEFT HAND: CA~30, CD~6, CA~2
Row 23: For RIGHT HAND: CA~30, CD~6, CA~2 For LEFT HAND: CA~2, CD~6, CA~30
Row 24: For RIGHT HAND: CA~3, CD~4, CA~31 For LEFT HAND: CA~31, CD~4, CA~3
Rows 25-27: For BOTH: With CA, sc in each st across.
Row 28: For BOTH: CA~17, CB~4, CA~17
Rows 29-30: For BOTH: CA~16, CB~6, CA~16
Row 31: For RIGHT HAND: CA~6, CC~3, CA~7, CB~6, CA~16 For LEFT
HAND: CA~16, CB~6, CA~7, CC~3, CA~6
Row 32: For RIGHT HAND: $C A \sim 17, C B \sim 4, C A \sim 7, C C \sim 5, C A \sim 5$ For LEFT
HAND: CA~5, CC~5, CA~7, CB~4, CA~17
Row 33: For RIGHT HAND: CA~5, CC~5, CA~28 For LEFT HAND: CA~28, CC~5, CA~5
Row 34: For RIGHT HAND: CA~29, CC~3, CA~6 For LEFT HAND: CA~6, CC~3, CA~29
Rows 35-37: For BOTH: With CA, sc in each st across.
Finishing: Do not fasten off at end of row 37, unless changing color. Ch 1, and, with right side facing, sc evenly around entore outer edge, placing 3 sc in each corner. Join to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Face:
Using yarn needle, and Black yarn, follow graph, to embroider the Snappy face on to your square.
